Course is for those who meet the minimum standards set by P.O.S.T. to become an evaluator

1. Should have a minimum of five years experience as a Law Enforcement K9 Handler or Law Enforcement K9 Trainer, and a minimum of 200 hours of documented training in the area they are evaluating.
2. Should pass a P.O.S.T.-certified K9 Team Evaluator Course.
3. **Attendees in the course must provide verification of prerequisites to the course presenter prior to the beginning of the course.**

We will need a letter from your supervisor that states you meet or exceed the minimum standards of five years as a handler. Please bring the letter or memo to the class and present it at registration.
